Restricted to Centre trial for solo drivers including Expert, A&B schoolboys who are members of clubs affiliated to the Wessex Centre ACU. Held under the NSC of the ACU, the Standing Regulations, Wessex Centre Rules and the following Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions which have or may be issued.

1. OFFICIALS: Wessex Centre Steward – ; Club Steward – Frank Sweeting; Clerk of the Course - Brian Shuttleworth; Secretary of the Meeting – Phyllis Sweeting, 185 Great Ashley, Bradford on Avon, Wilts, BA15 2PP. Tel 01225 862506
2. AWARDS: Main Route Experts A class - James Cup; Alternative route A/B class - Coronation Cup; Best B class – an award; Best C class - May Cup; Best Over 40 an award; Best Over 50 an award; All awards, with the exception of the James Cup, subject to a minimum of 6 entries per class. Runner up awards will be given if there is a minimum of 10 entries in class. Youth Expert, Youth A&B – award to winner in each class as long as there are 3 entries in class. No driver may win more than one award. Club cups to be held for one year only.
3. ENTRIES: Adult £12. Schoolboy entry fee £10. Entries to be made on the form below, accompanied by the entry fee and sent to the Secretary of the Meeting. **CLOSING DATE WEDNESDAY 6th FEBURARY.** Entries received after the closing date and up to 1 hour before the start will be accepted with an entry fee of £15. Cheques to be made payable to West Wilts Motor Club Ltd. One motorcycle to be ridden by one driver only during the trial. SAE with entry please, if you require a set of results. Club subscription £5.
4. START: Becky Addie Woods, Westwood, Bradford-on-Avon. OS map 173 Swindon & Devizes map ref 809598. First man’s time 10.30 am and the rest at one minute intervals.
5. TIES: If there is a tie, the driver with the greatest number of cleans will win. If still a tie, the first to gain advantage will win.
6. COURSE: On some sections there will be an easier route for A/B, B, C, Over 40 and 50 riders and to be eligible for their class awards, they must ride the easier route. Only riders riding their class defined route – main or alternative to qualify for championship points. This event is routed along and/or across public rights of way. Competitors must exercise caution and reduce their speed accordingly near other path users. Be especially careful near horses. Slow down, stop and switch off your engine if necessary.
